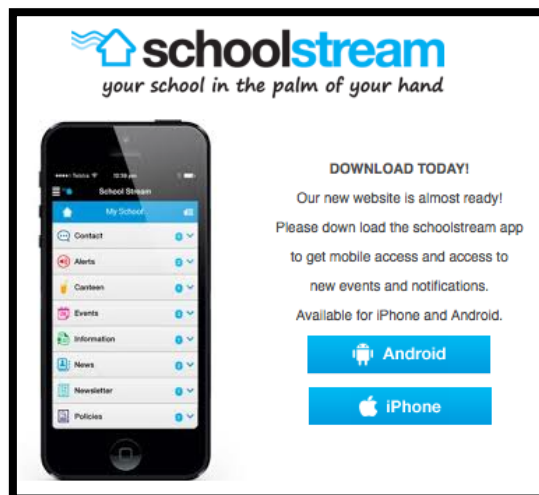
PROCLAIM LISMORE PARENTS 2014 – “IT TAKES A VILLAGE TO RAISE A CHILD”
